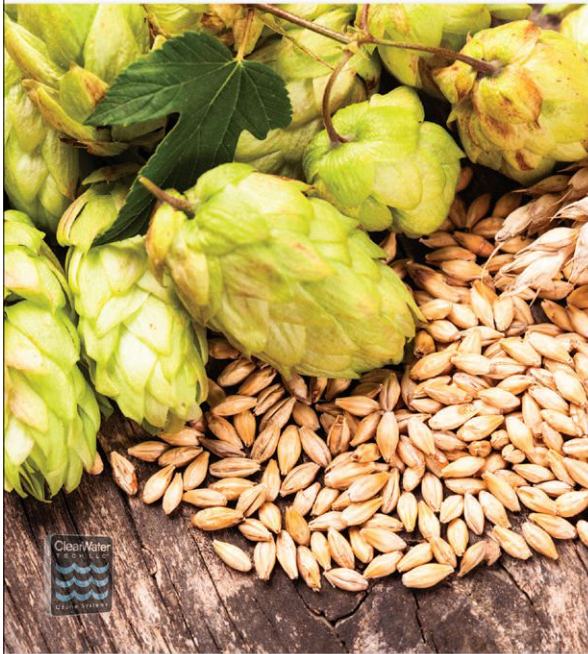

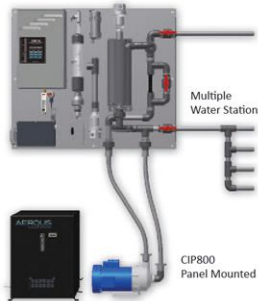

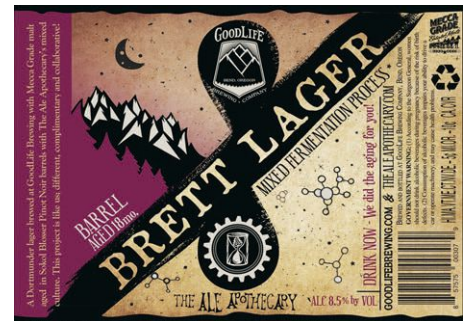

To create Brett Lager, GoodLife and The Ale Apothecary brewed a Dortmunder-style lager at GoodLife's production facility. After two months of cold-conditioning, the beer was transferred into Sokol Blosser barrels and allowed to warm up to ale temperatures. Then The Ale Apothecary's wild house yeast culture was added to further evolve the beer during the 18-month barrel aging process.
